iJET ensures that our clients are aware of potentially dangerous or disruptive incidents through pushed alerts via SMS text messages and e-mail. There are **three levels of intelligence alerts: informational, warning and critical**, each with its own criteria with respect to level and scope of impact and timeliness-in-reporting requirements. Every iJET alert requires a minimum of two independent sources for verification purposes.

- **Critical Alerts** imply that action is required. They address issues that will impact operations or travel. It is iJET policy to disseminate reporting of these types of events within 15 minutes of verification.
- **Warning Alerts** typically cover topics that require heightened awareness and may impact travel or operations.
- **Informational Alerts** are intended as FYIs and provide situational awareness. These issues are often predictions for things that may or may not require you to take any immediate action.

Situation Reports

Situation Reports cover developments, events or observations that almost certainly will not immediately impact operational risk but very well could have implications down the road. Situation Reports are published in our **Daily Intelligence Briefing**.

iJET maintains a robust database of intelligence on cities and countries around the globe. **Each location is assigned a threat level from one to five (1 Minimal, 2 Low, 3 Moderate, 4 High, 5 Very High)**. This is referred to as a **Country/City Security Assessment Rating (CSAR)** and is typically used by clients to set parameters for trip authorization and security. A variety of subscription-based reports are available, including:

- The **Daily Intelligence Briefing (DIB)** provides information about global noteworthy, risk-related events and developments. It is published daily providing in-depth coverage of current issues by region. It covers critical issues, easy-to-understand CSARs and alert levels and has an interactive feedback option to communicate with iJET analysts.
- The iJET **Health Intelligence Monitor (HIM)** is a weekly publication that helps you fulfill your Duty of Care requirements. It contains jargon-free timely information on issues of infectious disease, chemical contamination, radiation health and more. Its core focus is to provide valuable information on how these matters may impact travelers, security, and corporate resiliency.
- The iJET **Monthly Intelligence Forecast (MIF)** provides near-term geopolitical analysis of developments around the world that may impact organizational operations in the weeks ahead. As a more strategic outlook, the MIF is designed to offer our clients a 30-90 day assessment of various countries and issues.
- iJET's **Worldcue Airline Monitor (WAM)** advises clients about the world's fleet of commercial and charter airlines, focusing on overall safety based vectors including maintenance history, fleet age, corporate health. Our team uses the terms "preferred" or "non-preferred" rather than use or don't use. The system can also tell you if you have too many people on a single flight, potentially jeopardizing business continuity if tragedy strikes.

Intelligence Analysts

To accomplish our 24x7 mission, iJET employs a diverse staff of full-time analysts. The Global Watch team is organized by five regions: Africa (Sub-Saharan), Americas, Asia/So Pac, Europe & Russia/CIS, and Middle East/North Africa. The regional analysts are complemented by Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) who cover specific categories or sectors, such as health, transportation, security and oil, gas, and mining.

The backgrounds of iJET's Watch Operations staff are diverse, with analysts hailing from such places as the National Security Agency, U.S. Air Force Intelligence, U.S. Army Intelligence, US Marine Corps, USAID, South African Intelligence, Accenture, Transecur, Peace Corps, Center for Strategic and International Studies, Woodrow Wilson Center, World Bank, Jamestown Foundation, and many other institutions that have prepared them well to take on iJET's critical work.
